## **Cartus Again Named a GreenCircle Award Winner by Connecticut's Department of Energy and Environmental Protection**

Just some of the activities implemented and managed by the Cartus Conservation Committee include:

- A rideshare program that has grown to include more than 600 riders, with the majority using rideshare weekly
- Participation in the City of Danbury's Adopt-A-Street Program for the past 10 years; Cartus employees volunteer to clean up a city street each month from April through October
- Companywide use of approximately 30% recycled office products, and 25% of copy paper purchased has been recycled
- In 2015, Cartus eliminated all Styrofoam from corporate headquarters' cafeteria and switched to more environmentally friendly products

"I'm incredibly proud of each and every Cartus employee's extraordinary contribution to our conservation efforts, which resulted in our winning a GreenCircle Award again," said Cartus President and CEO Kevin Kelleher. "For more than a decade our company has made sustainability a top priority, and it's incredibly gratifying to our company—and our employees—to be acknowledged for these efforts."
